

Homemade Chatterbox Sprinkler Valve Locator

Requires knowledge of the approximate location of the valve.

Equipment:

Saw Blade

2 wires with 1 bare end and an alligator clip on the other end

1. Turn the sprinkler system off.
2. Disconnect the valve zone wire for the valve you wish find (zone 1, blue wire in this case) and connect the bare wire end in it's place (black wire in this case).
3. Clip the alligator end of the black wire to the saw blade.
4. Clip the other wire (white) to the zone wire (blue) with the alligator clip.
5. Turn the sprinkler zone on to provide power to the zone in question.
6. Slide the bare end of the white wire along the teeth of the saw blade (sparks indicate success) while someone else listens for the faint noise of the chattering valve in the yard and pinpoints the location.
